NEW DEVELOPMENTS

RENEWABLE ENERGY development company, the Banks Group, has secured the planning consent to build a £70 million waste to energy facility using Anaerobic Digestion (AD) technology at the Pond Green Energy Park near Bathgate.

WEST LOTHIAN still has one of the fastest growing and youngest populations in Scotland. The recently released mid-year population estimates for June 2009 show that the area's population now stands at 171,040, an increase of 1,540 over the June 2008 figure.



THE **UNEMPLOYMENT** rate in West Lothian for May 2010 (latest data released June 2010) is 4.6% (4,953 – a decrease of 88 on the previous month). West Lothian's rate is slightly above the Scottish (4.2%) and Great Britain (3.9%) rates.
